

HEALTH AND SAFETY OF LONE WORKERS



Lone workers employed in the healthcare or industrial sectors who carry out dangerous tasks must be able to rely on receiving rapid and complete support in critical situations. ATT AG offers various solutions aimed at ensuring the safety of lone workers: the alarm can be activated manually, in emergency situations it's recognised automatically. Due to accurate localisation and coordinated escalation help can be provided quickly and precisely.

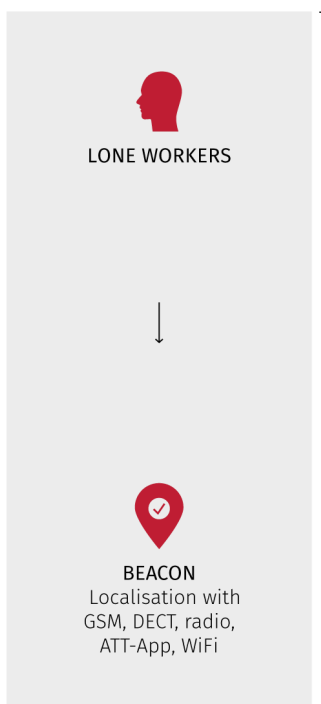
MANUALLY ACTIVATED ALARMS

People who work out of audibility or visibility of colleagues are exposed to elevated risks. In critical situations that might include human error Lone Workers must be able to send a distress call at any time. Emergencies can be reported at the press of a button using DECT technology or GSM. In the healthcare sector the Medicare Plus strategy is used, in which the alarm (nurse call) is transmitted via radio. An alarm can also be triggered via the ATT Alarm-APP. The person in need of assistance is then located and the alarm is passed on to an emergency call centre.

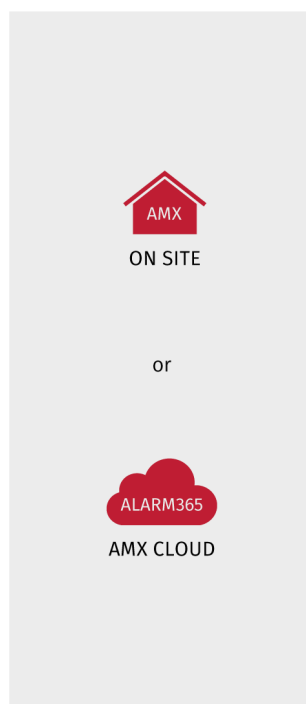
AUTOMATIC ALARMS

With the ATT Alarm-APP, a smartphone can become a safety device. An automatic, involuntary alarm can also be triggered through the app. Sensors are able to recognize unusual situations, so an alarm is triggered autonomously if a Lone Worker does not move for an extended period of time.
